



# SCHOOL ZONE SAFETY CHALLENGE

Elementary and high school students sometimes run into obstacles on their way to school. As parents and drivers, you play an important role in ensuring your children's safety. On top of regularly reminding your children about the basics when it comes to safety, you must also adopt a careful attitude when you are behind the wheel of your car. The Town of Mount Royal's Public Security invites you to accept the school zone safety challenge.

Take a few minutes to review your obligations when it comes to your children's safety in a danger zone:



**Respect the no stopping signs**  
Fine: \$30



**Respect the no parking signs**  
Fine: \$30



**Do not double-park**  
Fine: \$30



**Watch out for the children!**  
When approaching a school bus or minibus, whose flashing red lights and / or stop signal is deployed, stop your vehicle at least 5 meters away.  
Fine: from \$200 to \$300  
Demerit points: 9



**School crossing guard - Mandatory stop**  
You must always respect the school crossing guard's mandatory stop sign. His/her role is to guide and control the students when they cross the street  
Fine: from \$100 to \$200  
Demerit points: 3



**Be especially careful in a school zone!**  
Respect the speed limit and take weather conditions into account. Driving 10 km/h over the speed limit could be a matter of life or death for a child crossing your path.  
Fine and demerit points in proportion to the speed you were traveling at when pulled over
