

BY-LAW NO. 1419-4 AMENDING WATER SUPPLY BY-LAW NO. 1419 WITH RESPECT TO RATES AND POOL COMPENSATION

WHEREAS notice of motion was given on December 13, 2022 and the draft By-law was filed at the same council meeting;

ON, 2022, **COUNCIL ENACTED THE FOLLOWING:**

1. Section 69, 70 et 71 of Water supply By-law No. 1419 shall be amended:
 - (1) by repealing the words “on or after July 1, 2011,”;
 - (2) by replacing the words “two dollars and forty cents (\$2,40)” by the words “two dollars and sixty cents (\$2,60)”.

2. The said By-law shall be amended by adding the following sections after section 71:

“Pool compensation

 - 71.1 A pool compensation of \$100 is imposed and will be levied, each fiscal year, on any property on the property assessment roll that has a swimming pool.
 - 71.2 This compensation is payable by the owner of the property. It is then treated as a property tax imposed on the assessment unit comprising the immovable.
 - 71.3 This compensation is not refundable in the event that the pool is withdrawn during the fiscal year.”.

3. Section 72 of said By-law shall be amended by adding, after “the system fees”, the words “as well as the pool compensation”.

4. Section 74 of said By-law shall be amended by adding, after “and system fees”, the words “as well as pool compensation”.

5. This by-law shall come into effect according to the Law.
