REDEVELOPMENT ROADWORKS ON BATES ROAD

Dear Resident,

The Town will resume the Bates Road redevelopment project the week of **May 19, 2026 for approximately 12 weeks**. Prior to this, and depending on weather conditions, landscaping work may also begin in the areas built last fall.

Nature of the Work

Work will begin with the demolition of the existing sidewalks on the south side of the street to allow for Hydro-Québec's electrical substation work. Once Hydro-Québec's work is complete, the sidewalks will be rebuilt, the de Vimy and Pratt intersections will be reconfigured, and the pavement will be renewed. Landscaping of the new planting areas will complete the project.

Traffic and Access

The work will cause traffic disruptions on your street. **Local traffic will be permitted westbound towards Wilderton Avenue between Glendale Alley and Wilderton Avenue.** Bus circuit 160 of the STM

The Pratt and de Vimy intersections will be closed intermittently for the substation work. Outside of these closures, they will be accessible to local traffic.

During the milling (removal of the existing asphalt) and paving work, the street will be closed to all traffic between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. You will receive a notice before this work begins.

- Any areas affected by the work (lawns, driveways, paving, sidewalks) will be **fully restored after the project is completed**.
- There may be **periods of inactivity** during the project, due to wait times for laboratory test results.
