Construction of an underground transmission line
Section of Chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse under Highway 40

May 2025

To ensure the long-term operability of its facilities on the Island of Montréal and meet the growing demand for electricity in this area, Hydro-Québec is building an underground transmission line between Mont-Royal substation (Côte-des-Neiges–Notre-Dame-de-Grâce borough) and Saraguay substation (Saint-Laurent borough).

Type of work and duration

The work involves laying underground conduits in open trenches under Highway 40 to connect Avenue Sainte-Croix and Chemin Lucerne.

It will only take place on weekends.

The work will begin in early June and end in early August (the activities in the sector are currently being coordinated).

Each phase will take place over a period of three weekends.

Phases and impacts of the work

- **Phase 1: Section under westbound Chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse**
Complete closure of Avenue Sainte-Croix between Rue Dion and Chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse
- **Phase 2: Section under the Highway 40 overpass**
Only one northbound lane to cross Highway 40
- **Phase 3: Section under westbound Chemin de la Côte-de-Liesse**
Partial closure of Chemin Lucerne (one lane open to two-way traffic)

Impacts of the work

- Removal of parking spaces along the streets as needed
- Temporary traffic disruptions in the work area
- Noise from machinery during certain operations

Mitigation measures

- Appropriate signage
- Uninterrupted access to residences and businesses at all times
- Uninterrupted pedestrian access
- Flag persons to ensure safety around the jobsite
- Fencing to separate the pedestrian walkway from the jobsite

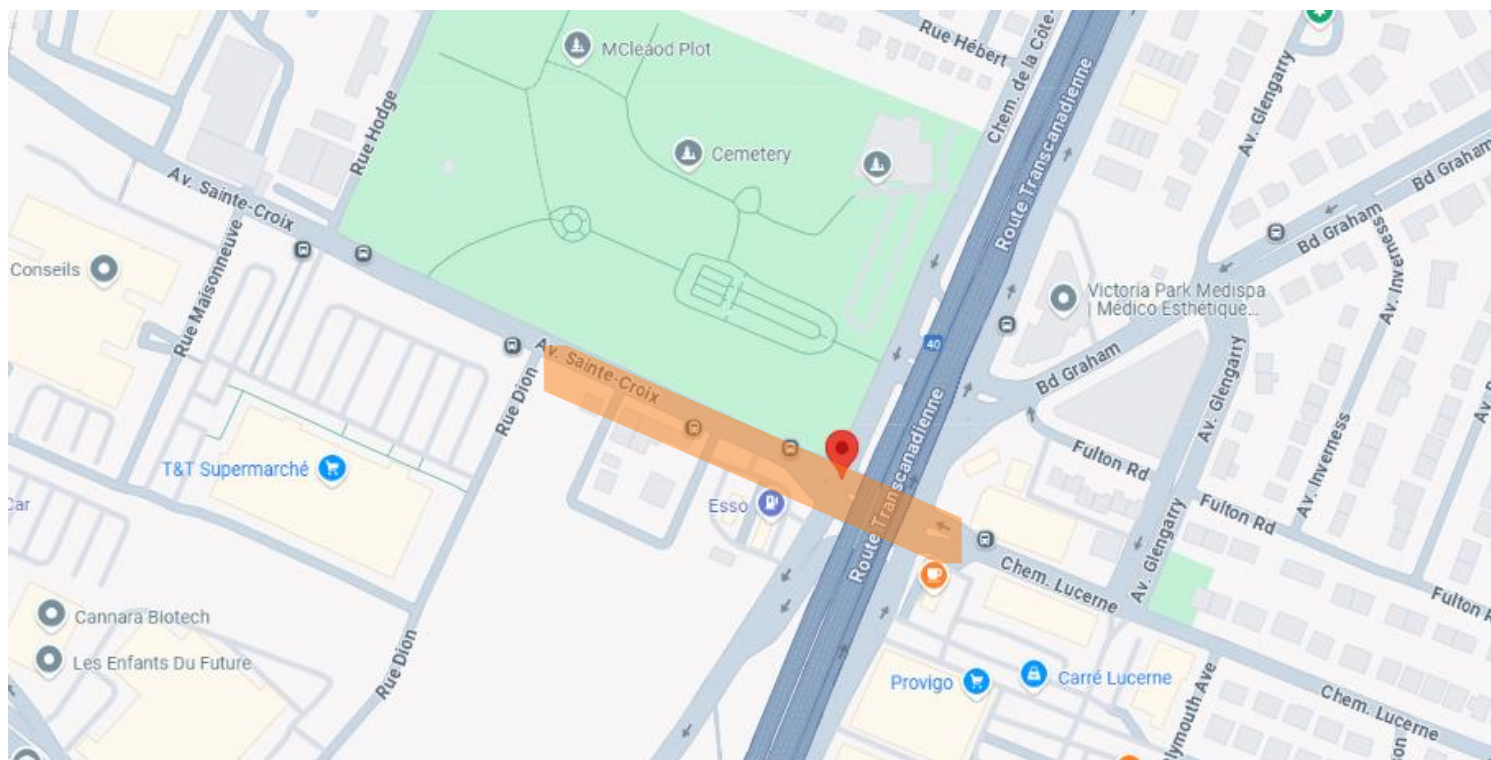
