Technical Sheet

Eastern Hemlock

(Tsuga canadensis)

Exposure: Shade or partial shade

Mature Height: 20 m

Mature Width: 9 m

Growth rate: Slow

Foliage:

- Needles are present in all seasons with a dark green colour and fine white bands underneath
- Needles are not pointed with a flat form and length of 1 to 2cm

Fruit: - Brown cones with rounded scales that measure 1.5 to 2.5cm

- Cones are pendulous and visible at the ends of lateral branches

Characteristics:

- Native tree that would prefer shaded areas of your yard
- Weak tolerance to drought and de-icing salts: preferably plant in the backyard
- Provides shelter and feeds birds
- Pyramidal form that becomes weeping with age
