

SCHEDULE 2024 Town of Mount Royal Pools and Wading Pool

MEMBERSHIP AND POOL ACCESS

RECREATION CARD

A valid Town of Mount Royal recreation card is mandatory to have access to the wading pool and to benefit from the RESIDENT daily access fees at the municipal pool and at the Pierre-Laporte pool. Cards may be purchased at 60 Roosevelt Avenue during office hours.

POOL AND WADING POOL

Summer membership to the municipal pool (resident and non resident) can be purchased online or at the Recreation Department at all times. Entrance to the pool and wading pool is through the main entrance. The side gate of the main pool will always be closed. The Pierre-Laporte pool will be open for additional adult swim hours.

NON-RESIDENT

A non-resident may access the installations by either purchasing a seasonal membership or by paying the daily access fees.

SWIMMING CATEGORIES AT THE MUNICIPAL POOL

PUBLIC: Access for all ages. **ONE** swimming lane is available and a second one may be temporaraly added, upon request and according to attendance. Diving boards and slide available.

RECREATIONAL: Access for all ages. **THREE** swimming lanes are available at all times. Diving boards and slide available.

ADULT: Acces reserved for adults (15 and over) only. At least THREE swimming lanes available. The deep end may be used for flottation and relaxation if the diving boards and the slide are not used.

The Town of Mount Royal reserves the right to modify the swimming or activities schedule.

- 2. Any alcoholic beverage, drug, cigarette or electronic cigarette is banned in public areas.
- 3. <u>Children under the age of 7 must be accompanied by an adult in the</u> water at all times, within an arm's length.
- 4. Parents must supervise their children at all times at the pool and at the wading pool.
- 5. Children who are 7 years old and over must go in their respective dressing room.
- 6. The lifequard has full authority over the application of the pool rules. No lack of respect will be tolerated.
