

BY-LAW NO. 1455 CONCERNING THE REMUNERATION PAID TO COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR 2019 AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS

WHEREAS section 2 of the Act Respecting the Remuneration of Elected Municipal Officers (C.L.R.Q., c. T-11.001) allows Council to fix, by by-law, the remuneration of the Mayor and Councillors;

WHEREAS notice of motion was given on December 17, 2018;

WHEREAS a draft by-law was filed on December 17, 2018;

WHEREAS a draft by-law was tabled on December 17, 2018;

ON JANUARY 28, 2019, COUNCIL ENACTED THE FOLLOWING:

1. For the 2019 fiscal year and retroactively to January 1, 2019, the annual remuneration of the Mayor and Councillors of Town of Mount Royal shall be as follows:
 - Mayor: \$54,853.43
 - Councillors: \$18,284.48

2. The annual remuneration of the Mayor for the 2020 and 2021 fiscal years shall be determined by adding \$6,073.79 to the amount paid to him as annual remuneration paid during the preceding fiscal year and by indexing upwards the amount so obtained by the same percentage as provided in section 4.

3. The annual remuneration of the Councillors for the 2020 and 2021 fiscal years shall be determined by adding \$2,024.60 to the amount paid to them as annual remuneration during the preceding fiscal year and by indexing upwards the amount so obtained by the same percentage as provided in section 4.

4. The annual remuneration of the Mayor and the Councillors for the fiscal years 2022 and beyond shall be indexed by increasing annual remuneration for the preceding year by a percentage corresponding to the rate of increase of the Consumer Price Index established for the whole of Quebec by Statistics Canada.

5. In the event that the Acting Mayor replaces the Mayor for more than thirty days, the Acting Mayor shall be entitled, from that moment until the replacement ends, to a sum equal to the remuneration of the Mayor for the period.

6. For a given fiscal year, the expense allowance for the Mayor and the Councillors shall be equal to half the amount of remuneration to which they are respectively entitled for the fiscal year concerned, up to the maximum determined by applying section 19 of the Act Respecting the Remuneration of Elected Municipal Officers (C.L.R.Q., c. T-11.001).

7. In addition to the remuneration fixed above, the Town shall pay an additional remuneration to Councillors who hold the following positions:
 - d) Pension Fund Commission:
 - Chair \$200/meeting
 - Vice-chair \$100/meeting
 - e) Planning Advisory Committee (CCU):
 - Chair \$250/meeting
 - f) Standing Commissions:
 - Chair \$200/meeting

8. By-law No. 1425 is repealed.

9. This by-law comes into effect on January 1, 2019, and shall come into force according to law.
