

BY-LAW NO. 1461 TO DIVIDE THE TOWN'S TERRITORY INTO EIGHT ELECTORAL DISTRICTS

ADOPTION PROCEDURE SUMMARY

WHEREAS notice of motion for this by-law was given on June 15, 2020 and the draft by-law was filed at the same council meeting;

WHEREAS under section 9 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities (C.Q.L.R. c. E-2.2) (the Act), the number of electoral districts in the Town shall not be fewer than 8 nor more than 12;

WHEREAS Council deems it advisable and necessary to proceed with the division of the Town's territory into eight electoral districts so as to meet the requirements of section 12 of the Act.

ON JULY 13 2020, COUNCIL ENACTED THE FOLLOWING:

1. The Town of Mount Royal shall be divided into eight electoral districts described and bounded as follows:

Electoral District No. 1

Starting at the intersection of Beaumont Avenue and the northeast Town boundary, the northeast and southeast Town boundaries, the rear lot line of Rockland Road (southwest side), the Graham Boulevard, Brookfield Avenue, the rear lot line of Rockland Road (southwest side, - including 295 Brookfield Avenue and 280 Trenton Avenue) and the northwest and northeast Town boundaries to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 909 electors, a +6.95 % variation from the mean, and an area of 1.09 km².

Electoral District No. 2

Starting at the intersection of Melbourne Avenue and Laird Boulevard, Laird Boulevard, Canora Road, the REM railroad tracks, the northwest Town boundary, the rear lot line of Rockland Road (southwest side) and Melbourne Avenue to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 797 electors, a +0.67% variation from the mean, and an area of 0.54 km².

Electoral District No. 3

Starting at the intersection of Melbourne Avenue and Laird Boulevard, Melbourne Avenue, the rear lot line of Rockland Road (southwest side - excluding 280, Trenton Avenue and 295, Brookfield Avenue), Brookfield Avenue, Graham Boulevard, Canora Road and Laird Boulevard to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 668 electors, a -6.55 % variation from the mean, and an area of 0.65 km².

Electoral District No. 4

Starting at the intersection of Canora Road and Graham Boulevard, Graham boulevard, the rear lot line of Rockland Road (southwest side), the southeast and southwest Town boundaries, the REM railroad tracks and Canora Road to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 975 electors, a +10.64% variation from the mean, and an area of 0.50 km².

Electoral District No. 5

Starting at the intersection of the REM railroad tracks and the southeast Town boundary, the southeast Town boundary, Saint-Clare Road, Kindersley Avenue, Graham Boulevard, Dunkirk Road and the REM railroad tracks to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 546 electors, a -13.39% variation from the mean, and an area of 0.75 km².

Electoral District No. 6

Starting at the intersection of the northwest Town boundary and the REM railroad tracks, the REM railroad tracks, Dunkirk Road, Graham Boulevard, Lazard Avenue, Winton Road, Strathcona Road, MacNeil Road and the northwest Town boundary to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 832 electors, a +2.63 %variation from the mean, and an area of 0.49 km².

Electoral District No. 7

Starting at the intersection of the northwest Town boundary and MacNeil Road, MacNeil Road, Strathcona Road, Winton Road, Lazard Avenue, Graham Boulevard, Kindersley Avenue, Saint-Clare Road, Kindersley Avenue, Lucerne Road, to Algonquin Avenue, the rear lot line of Lucerne Road (northeast side) and the northwest Town boundary to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 668 electors, a -6.55% variation from the mean, and an area of 0.77 km².

Electoral District No. 8

Starting at the intersection of the northwest Town boundary and the rear lot line of Lucerne Road (northeast side), the rear lot line of Lucerne Road (northeast side) to Algonquin Avenue, Lucerne Road, Kindersley Avenue, Saint-Clare Road and the southeast, southwest and northwest Town boundaries to the starting point.

Such district shall comprise 1 884 electors, a +5.55% variation from the mean, and an area of 2.66 km².

The boundaries of the electoral districts are described clockwise.

References to roadways are to their centre line unless otherwise provided.

Any reference to the rear line of a roadway means that the electoral district boundaries pass behind the sites fronting the roadway mentioned. The side of such roadway is defined by a cardinal point.

- 2. This by-law shall come into effect on October 31, 2020 according to section 30 of the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities.
